The Case Manager/ Children's Services Specialist is responsible for providing strengths based, intensive case management services to assist program participants to effectively complete their goals for achieving independence while living at Saint Louise House. He/ she will also serve as the lead on developing parenting, teen, and children's group curriculum and activities.

Case Management:

- Utilizes a solution-focused/ strengths based on-site case management to an assigned case load of program participants

Children's Services Specialist:

- Serves as the lead facilitator for the children's psych-educational group.
- Develops curriculum and plans activities for children's, parenting, and teen groups.
- Works in partnership with Volunteer Coordinator to plan children's events
- Develops opportunities for teen participation and input
